INVOCATION - Todd Lamphere - The Invocation was given by Team Chaplain Todd Lamphere .

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – Mayor Land led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

INTRODUCTION - Doug Guthrie, Principal, Apopka High School - Mayor Land introduced Principal Guthrie, who was sitting with him on the dais. He explained that Head Coach Rick Darlington was out of the state.

RESOLUTION

- 1. RESOLUTION NO. 2012-19** - Honoring the Apopka High School 2012 State Class 8A Football Champions.

The City Clerk read the resolution, titled as follows, in its entirety:

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, HONORING THE APOPKA HIGH SCHOOL 2012 STATE CLASS 8A FOOTBALL CHAMPIONS, AND JOINING THE COMMUNITY IN CONGRATULATION AND RECOGNITION.

Mayor Land opened the meeting for a public hearing. No one wishing to speak, he closed the public hearing.

MOTION was made by Commissioner Arrowsmith, and seconded by Commissioners McQueen, Dean, and Kilsheimer, to adopt Resolution No. 2012-19. Motion carried unanimously, with Mayor Land and Commissioners Arrowsmith, Dean, McQueen, and Kilsheimer voting aye.


DISCUSSION - Committee - Dave Rankin - David Rankin, appointed fundraising chairman by Mayor Land, extended the Community's pride in the accomplishment of the AHS Football Team. He explained that Old Florida National Bank and Paul Seago of the Apopka Chamber will be sponsoring a Bar-B-Q for the team. He will be seeking donations from the community to honor the team players with Super Bowl style rings and jackets. He said all monies will be handled through the Apopka Community Trust.

REMARKS - Principal Doug Guthrie and Coach Rick Darlington - Principal Guthrie said Coach Darlington was out of the state. He thanked the Mayor, City Commissioners, and the City of Apopka for its support during the football season. He then presented Mayor Land, on behalf of the City, with one of the championship medals given the players (each player was wearing their medal to the meeting). He also presented the entire City Council with a T-shirt that had been distributed for the Championship game, and gave Mayor Land a cap. He then introduced his coaching staff.
