Currently, the Mayor is elected citywide and serves as the Chair of the City Commission. The Mayor is the chief executive officer responsible for overseeing the administrative functions of the City. While the charter describes and designates the charter office of City Attorney and Clerk, the City Administrator is not a charter officer.

Make no changes in the City Charter on the duties and election of the Mayor but create the charter office of City Administrator.
